

Schools' Update about Tri-borough Music Hub engagement in 2016-17

The Tri-borough Music Hub (TBMH) is a centralised Local Authority service which operates to support all schools and pupils. Here is a summary of activity in 2016-17 that schools may want to plan for in order to access and benefit from the TBMH.

i. CPD Programme

We deliver termly CPD for primary, secondary and SEN/D covering key themes and updates regarding best music education practice. Schools can access all of this for either £100 per year as a 'School Partner' or for £75 per session.
